

2012 Community Garden Work(ing)shop Series

Green Spaces Alliance is helping to green San Antonio. Their Community Gardens Program works with 33 neighborhood groups to create community gardens throughout the city. To share their wealth of information resources, Green Spaces will host **six gardening work(ing)shops throughout 2012**. In these aptly named "work(ing)shops," participants learn by combining knowledge from the classroom with hands-on garden applications.

The work(ing)shops are held at local community gardens. Green Spaces invites expert gardeners, community members, and volunteers to share theory and then direct participants in applying the techniques for regionally-appropriate gardening. Each work(ing)shop addresses a new lesson vital to maintaining gardens in South Central Texas. Techniques may be universally applied to community gardens, landscapes, and backyard plots.

Each workshop costs \$5.00 per person. All work(ing)shops begin at 9:00 am and end at 12:00 pm. Light snacks and beverages will be available. Please bring your own chair to sit in.
